



## Wilderness and Remote First Aid

Whether you're a scout, an outdoor enthusiast or you work in a remote environment, our Wilderness and Remote First Aid course gives you the skills you need to respond to an emergency when help may be delayed. This course is based on the Boy Scouts of America *Wilderness First Aid Curriculum and Doctrine Guidelines*.

To prepare participants to give care for potentially life-threatening injuries when EMS response may be an hour or more away, the Red Cross Wilderness and Remote First Aid course covers the following topics:
